

Professor J. Michael Collins is the Fetzer Family Chair in Consumer & Personal Finance, a Professor of Public Affairs, and an affiliate of the Institute for Research on Poverty at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Collins leads the Center for Financial Security, a Social Security Administration Retirement and Disability Research Consortium research center. He studies household finance, especially consumer financial decisions and financial well-being over the life course. He has over 75 published research papers and reports. Collins brings nearly a decade of applied experience to his research. He founded PolicyLab Consulting Group, a research consulting practice, and co-founded [SpringFour](#), an cloud-based platform to refer consumers to sources of assistance. He also puts his research into practice for thousands of employees and retirees across the state as the chair of the Wisconsin Tax Sheltered Annuity Committee and as part of the Governor's Retirement Savings Task Force. Professor Collins has a PhD from Cornell University and an MPP from Harvard's Kennedy School.
